SUB: OBSERVATION OF BANK NATIONALIZATION DAY ON 19TH JULY, 2018

You are aware that the historic Bank Nationalisation day is just 9 days away. At a time, when the public sector banking space is facing a hostile attack from the powers that be, it is imperative for AIBOC, the largest Trade Union of Bank Officers' which has been playing the role of a conscious protector of Public Sector Banks, to observe 49th anniversary of bank nationalization in a befitting manner. The occasion has assumed greater significance owing to the fact that we will be accomplishing 50 glorious years of bank nationalization exactly after a year from July 19, 2018.
