### COUNTRYWIDE AGITATION BY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF RBI FRATERNAL SUPPORT TO THE AGITATION OF UFRBOE

United Forum of Reserve Bank Officers & Employees (UFRBOE) has launched an agitation demanding one more option to switch over to Pension, a Contributory Provident Fund and automatic updation of Pension. With a continuation of the program they propose to go on Mass Casual Leave on 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> September 2018.

2. Comrades, updation of pension and scrapping of NPS are important issues. We have been demanding this in every forum.
