Leave Travel Concession/Home Travel Concession

Please refer to your letter No. CIR/HR & IR/F/2014-15/9195 dated April 7, 2014, on the captioned matter, addressed to all public sector member banks. You will kindly agree that the issue of leave travel concession is a bilateral issue and the provisions of the scheme have been the subject matter of discussion in the last settlements, including that of 9th bipartite settlement. The present Charter of Demand submitted on 30th October, 2012 also contains a separate demand for review of the existing scheme in a comprehensive manner. Any unilateral change in the scheme for leave travel concession is violative of the spirit of bilateralism and is therefore not acceptable to us. Therefore, we request and demand from you that the decision of the Managing Committee of IBA held on 01/04/2014 and conveyed by your letter dated April 7, 2014, should be withdrawn immediately.

We sincerely hope that our request will be considered in all seriousness and its implementation will be stopped immediately.
