We have already advised the outcome of our first two action programmes vide our Circular No. 2015/79 dated 04.12.2015. The reports are pouring in from various centres regarding the successful implementation of our today's agitational programme of holding Common demonstration by the State Committees at all State Capitals & Major centres.

We place on record a deep appreciation for the comrades of our Tamil Nadu State Committee who have been braving the nature's fury and helping the people in distress on one hand and on the other hand, have shown exemplary indomitable spirit in holding the demonstration wherever possible and kept the flag of AIBOC flying high.

At Delhi, the demonstration was held at the heart of the city near the Parliament at Allahabad Bank, Parliament Street Branch where more than 1000 comrades, including DROs and lady comrades in huge ratio, gathered and attracted the attention of passerby with their forceful ranting of slogans. The members were addressed by Com. Harvinder Singh, the General Secretary of the Confederation, Com. Ajay Jaitley and Com. Sunil Bansal, the President and Secretary of Delhi State Committee.
