MARCH TO DELHI ON 4TH FEBRUARY, 2019

As decided in the recently held General Secretaries meet on 04th January, 2019, at Kolkata, a 'Maha Morcha' will be organised on 04th February, 2019, at National Capital on various issues concerning the Officers Community of the entire Banking Industry. Officers of various Central Govt. organisations and Public Sector Undertakings under the banner of All India Public Sector and Central Govt. Officers' Confederation (AIPCOC) will also participate in the Morcha. The Maha Morcha would commence in the form of a massive 'Jatha' from Modern School, Barakhamba Road, Delhi, at 11 a.m. and proceed towards Parliament Street (Sansad Marg) via Tolstoy Marg and finally culminate into the 'Morcha' at Jantar Mantar, Parliament Street. The rally / demonstration would commence at 12.30 p.m. and is expected to be continued upto 4 p.m. The rally would be addressed by AIBOC leadership, Hon'ble Members of Parliament, leadership of fraternal organisations as well as leaders of various central trade unions and eminent citizens.

The core objectives of the 'Maha Morcha' are:

- 1) Opposing the proposed Merger/Amalgamation of Vijaya Bank, Dena Bank and Bank of Baroda.
- 2) Opposing the **Merger** of Regional Rural Banks (**RRBs**).
- 3) Demanding Scrapping of New Pension Scheme (NPS) and restoration of Defined Pension scheme.
- 4) Demanding **Updation of Pension** and **revision of Family Pension**.
- 5) Protesting Attack and Assault on bankers.
- 6) Demanding publication of list of wilful corporate defaulters.
- 7) Demanding immediate appointment of **Workmen and Officer Directors** in Boards of all the PSBs.
- 8) Opposing fractured mandate for Officers (instead of full and complete mandate covering all Officers in Scale I to VII) and demanding decent wage revision in 11th Bipartite Settlement based on 'Charter of Demand' submitted by four Officers' organisations.
- 9) Demanding adequate recruitment in PSBs.
- 10) Opposing Mis-selling of Third Party Products.

While the preparatory agitation programmes announced by AIBOC from 10th January, 2019 to 17th January, 2019 including 'Human Chain' / 'Candle Light Rally' was organised at all state capitals, district headquarters and important centres across the country and evoked overwhelming response, further programs in preparation of the Maha Morcha would be advised shortly. We are confident that, 04th of February, 2019 would culminate in a show of colossal strength of the officers fraternity in the Banking Industry.

We, therefore, call upon all the Affiliates to effectively plan for participation of maximum number of activists from Delhi / NCR and also the nearby Regions / Zones / Circles so as to ensure achievement of the target set by the Confederation. Accordingly, the leadership of the State Units of Delhi, UP, Uttaranchal, Himachal Pradesh, J&K, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh need to convene their respective State Committee Meetings immediately for ensuring maximum participation.

We would like to request the affiliates and state units to approach the leadership and members of all pensioners and retirees organisations, in their respective area, and urge them to actively support our struggle and ensure presence of all local Retired Members / Pensioners in the 'Maha Morcha'. . .
