### **AIBOC EXTENDS ITS FRATERNAL SUPPORT AND SOLIDARITY TO THE GENERAL STRIKE ON 12.02.2026 CALLED BY CENTRAL TRADE UNIONS AND INDEPENDENT SECTORAL FEDERATIONS OF WORKERS**

The All-India Bank Officers' Confederation (AIBOC), along with six other unions/associations in the banking industry, has extended its whole hearted support and solidarity for the General Strike scheduled on the 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 vide the joint circular dated 29.01.2026. This strike has been called by the joint platform of Central Trade Unions and various independent sectoral federations of workers and employees, where AIBEA, AIBOA and BEFI are also participating.

AIBOC categorically opposes the four Labour Codes which subsume 29 existing labour laws designed to weaken workers' rights while favouring corporate interests. These codes represent a systematic dilution of protections hard-won through decades of struggle and sacrifice. We are gravely concerned by systematic curtailment of legitimate trade union rights, while simultaneously, corporates have been granted increased latitude in effecting closures and layoffs with diminished statutory safeguards for workers. Such developments constitute a direct assault on the fundamental rights and dignities of the working class. AIBOC firmly resolves to resist these regressive measures through collective action, oppose privatisation of critical sectors including banking and financial services and continue to advocate for an equitable economic framework wherein workers' rights, public institutions and social justice remain paramount.

We call upon all our affiliates and state units to participate in protest demonstrations or meetings organized by the sponsors of the strike, especially the associations of financial institutions to express our solidarity and support for its cause. Additionally, our members will not act as strike-breakers nor take on any non-supervisory duty on the day of the strike.
